

John Keane is the founder and Director of the *Sydney Democracy Network*. He is Professor of Politics at the University of Sydney and at the Wissenschaftszentrum Berlin (WZB). In 1989 he founded the world's first Centre for the Study of Democracy in London. During his many years in Europe, The Times ranked him one of Britain's leading political thinkers and a writer whose work has 'world-wide importance'. The Australian Broadcasting Corporation (ABC) recently described him as "one of Australia's great intellectual exports". His *Life and Death of Democracy* was short-listed for the 2010 Non-Fiction Prime Minister's Literary Award.
